The old version of the Lord's Prayer and the new version are most different in today's section:

Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Save us from the time of trial and deliver us from evil.

What's that about? The old version makes us think about "temptations" like grabbing that extra chocolate bar or maybe worse, but that's not what Jesus was trying to teach the disciples. He was saying that when the chips are really down, when the "valley of the shadow of death" seems all about, that's the time to call upon God to keep you steadfast, protect you and come to the rescue.

We have times in our personal journey when God seems to have deserted us, the green pasture seems long behind, the future uncertain. We are also increasingly in a time when our faith may not be well received and suddenly what seemed a comfortable discipleship turns into a confrontation.

In these verses, Jesus is upping the stakes and talking not about little temptations, but the big challenges. He wants us to be ready and know that when that happens God is our protector - call upon Him.
