Giving Sunday: March 30th, 2025 What you give to God – he multiples. Exodus 35: 5a "From what you have – take an offering for the Lord"

Vestry is mindful of the running costs for Holy Trinity and we want to ensure we are good stewards of the facilities and gifts that God has entrusted to us, while honouring our staff. Our 2025 budget is forecasting a deficit of \$66,450 at 31 December 2025.

Please prayerfully consider what you can give to God, through supporting Holy Trinity's finances. As part of the Holy Trinity family, we really need everyone to contribute what they are able to. Regular automatic payments are wonderful as Vestry can budget on this income and make strategic decisions accordingly.

However, Sunday, 30th March is to be a special Giving Sunday where we are asking parishioners to make a "one-off" gift (in addition to your regular giving). Donations made before March 31st qualify for a 33.3% tax credit. It may be easiest for you to donate via internet banking during the week beginning March 24th, using the word 'special' as a reference; then on Sunday 30th you may choose to write the amount you have given on a piece of paper, folded up, which you can bring forward as a "Gift to God" during the service. There will be credit card facilities available on the day too, for anyone who chooses to give this way. Cash can also be brought forward in the giving basket.
