First, their learning of truth is a matter of diligence rather than convenience. They want to know more and they will put much time and effort into it.

Second, they are not hearers who merely accumulate information. They want to know truth in order to understand it, embrace it, obey it, apply it and be transformed by it.

Third, they share the truth - by words, deeds, and lifestyle. They give it away, and the more they do, the more God wants to give them. It's unlimited. The opposite is also true.

In these ways, we are "rightly handling the word of truth" (2 Timothy 2:15 ESV). It achieves the purposes God intended, and the blessings are incalculable.
