Forum Discussion

Parishioners are invited to attend a Forum on Sunday 28 October at 10am to discuss the question, "What is God calling Holy Trinity to Focus on for the next five years". This will build on the foundation of the parish decision made on 2 September to be part of the new Christian Community network. It won't be a decision-making Forum, but will enable us to talk about what is of fundamental importance for Holy Trinity going ahead.

Vestry will engage that same question at its October meeting. We will have Life Group studies available for the pre-Christmas season. All that will feed into Vestry considerations in the New Year and come back for a more planning-oriented Forum. The 8am service will be cancelled that day - we will have an opening hymn or song and a prayer, then the Forum and a short communion to finish. Some parishioners are having open home lunches to follow.
