Three Types of Prayer

Quick and Urgent

"Lord, I need a car park" - it actually amazes me how the Lord delights in granting small things. The prayer for a car-park works for more that it should or I deserve. But that's ok - Phil 4:6 "in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God."

Intercession

I am learning to linger - to sense what, on my list of things to pray for, the Lord wants me to focus on at a deeper level. Jesus himself helps us to pray, speaking on our behalf into God's ear. Romans 8:34 "Christ Jesus ... is at the right hand of God and is ... interceding for us."

Full Armour of God

"Our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms" Eph 6:12 - so put on the full armour of God.
