- Meet at least twice a month.
- Do some Biblical study (at times provided by vicars/other staff).
- Pray- intercede & pray for each other.
- Care for one another.
- Keep each other accountable by asking the 2 questions" "What is God saying to you? And, "What are you doing about it?"
